

Conservation Actions

Monitoring

- Maintain current BBS coverage
- Repeat BB Atlas at 20-year intervals
 - Meet or exceed Atlas goals for coverage (Point Counts & Breeding Abundance)
- Put in Place Habitat Monitoring & reporting
- Meet Continental targets for Migration Monitoring
- Evaluate winter coverage of focal species through CBC

Conservation Actions

Research & Evaluation

- Establish habitat models for priority species in southern Ontario
- Identify suitable and potentially restorable habitat
- Evaluate alternative management approaches to maintain / enhance grassland & shrubland habitats used by priority landbirds
- Initiate demographic studies of a few key species in relation to habitat / landscape / mgmt

Conservation Actions

Habitat Management

- Identify protected lands with greatest potential to be managed for priority species / habitat
- Identify priority lands for securement / restoration
- Allow disturbance (flooding, fire, beavers) to natural lands to maintain shrubland in the landscape
- Retain large trees / dead snags for nesting
